

What does a Thermal Back Scan do?

A thermal back scan utilizes an infra-red sensor to assess temperatures adjacent to the spinal column. According to the literature we found it is the variation from one side to the other which depicts abnormal nerve function at that particular level.

The readings are then entered into a database and compared with normal findings. The Doctor prints out the results and now has a visual aide to demonstrate to the patient their sites of improper nerve, blood flow.
